Where Are The Wild Things?

As Authors...

Can you draw and label a picture of a fearsome Wild Thing?

Can you make a wanted poster for a Wild Thing or missing Fairy Tale Creature?

Can you draw a picture and write a sentence about a creature that might live in our MILL POND?

As Speakers/Performers...

Perform a Traditional Fairy tale out loud?

Or learn a speech from one of the main characters to perform? Fe Fi Fo Fum

As Readers...

Read/ share as many traditional stories as you can.

Talk about the characters and make predictions about what you think will happen.

As Mathematicians...

We will be learning number bonds up to 20.

Can you make a 'matching pairs' poster for a teen number?

Choose your favourite 2-digit number and make a poster about it.

Go on a maths walk around the Millpond. Can you find a circle? Square? Can you see and pairs of things?

How many swans are there? Geese? Are there more Geese than ducks? Which trees are the tallest? How tall do you think they are? How many steps does it take to cross the bridge?

As Historians...

Find out about your family history and make a simple timeline.

We will be learning about how life has changed since the 1970s- can you find out how toys/ technology has changed since then?

Geographers...

Can you draw a map of your route to school? What features do you walk past?

Find out 3 facts about the Millpond and the creatures that live there.

Find where you live on a map of the UK. Can you find the nearest town? City? Seaside place?

As Designers...

Use a tin tray or shoebox to make your own mini garden.

Can you make a Wild Thing creature collage?

Can you design an outfit and hairstyle for a punk?

As Children...

We want you to be able to demonstrate our school values at home as well as at school.

Can you write 3 ways that you are respectful at home?

Do you follow a family code you could bring in and share?

Can you bring in a photograph of you being helpful at home or at a relative's house?

Can you help to make a family meal or snack? Make a little video or bring in photographs to share your recipe with the class.

As Scientists...

We will be exploring animals and their habitats.

Have you got a pet or would like a pet? Write all about it, how you look after it and what it needs to be happy and healthy.

Can you draw a life cycle of butterfly/ frog etc?

Go on a nature walk to find 3 different types of trees. Can you draw their leaves and find out what type of tree they are?

In Year 1, we challenge you to choose 6 Take Home Challenges to complete. When completed tick off your challenge and bring your completed challenge to school to be celebrated in our classroom.

As a guide we would like ALL children to try and complete 3 challenges each half term.
