Blended remote learning with access to Google Classroom has been a great success and we are excited to keep working with this platform. Children must access the Google Classroom for two online meets a day. These are a 9 am morning meet, which allows us to register the children and explain the activities for the day and a 10:50 am maths meet where we teach the maths lesson live and can offer immediate support. Please ensure children are attending both.

We are using Google Classroom to keep track of the work children are producing and to be able to offer feedback and support with this work, this means it is vital the children's work is submitted to the assignment in the classroom, with a photo being uploaded for any work completed in their books or on paper.
